LB 1195 repeals Neb. Rev. Stat. § 47-111.

This removes county jail requirements that specifically addressed supervision and staffing for female prisoners, including provisions related to appointing a matron and certain staffing expectations in larger counties. As a result, counties would no longer be required to follow § 47-111 role-specific requirements and would continue operating under other applicable jail standards and policies.

There is no fiscal impact.
