LB 1111 amends statute regarding electricity.

The bill requires an annual report be presented to the Power Review Board by an agency representing the industry.

This report is identified as the data center load report. The statute expands on what is to be included in the report.

The bill requires large data centers to pay the full cost of the public power provider to expand infrastructure to accommodate the data center. It disallows these costs to be carried by the other customers of the public power provider. It allows alternative proposals to meet the load requirement of the large data center through private agreements or self-generation.

It outlines requirements for the decommissioning of large data centers and for the sharing of information regarding large data centers with the public.

It allows a public power supplier to interrupt services to large data centers according to their policy.
