LB 30 gives the Real Estate Commission the authority to levy civil fines on licensees as a form of disciplinary action. Such fines cannot exceed \$2,500 per complaint. Any fine revenue is to be distributed to common schools in accordance with Article VII, section 5, of the state Constitution.

LB 30 may increase civil fine revenue distributed to schools, but the amount is indeterminate, since fines are levied on a case-by-case basis that cannot be predicted with any accuracy. In addition, since this authority is new, there is not a track record to indicate how extensive the Commission will use this additional disciplinary tool.
