LB 71 would require animal care professionals to report animal abandonment, cruel neglect or cruel mistreatment. If additional reports were made as result of LB 71, additional criminal justice resources (law enforcement, prosecutors, public defenders, jails, prisons) could be devoted to investigating complaints. It is unknown how many, if any, additional investigations would occur as a result of LB 71, and therefore, it will have an indeterminate impact on criminal justice expenditures.
