LB 39 restricts certain evidence from being admissible in any civil or criminal proceeding involving alleged sexual misconduct.

The Supreme Court estimates the bill's provisions may have minimal costs due to programming changes for the JUSTICE system. These cost can be absorbed within currently budgeted resources.
