LB 379 would extend the length of time that grants of up to \$1,000,000 be available for new scap tire projects from the Waste Reduction and Recycling Incentive Fund. Current law ends the \$1,000,000 designation on June 30,2009. LB 370 would extend the designation until June 30, 2014. LB 379 could impact the type of grants approved from the Waste Reduction and Recycling Incentive Fund, but it would not change the total amount of expenditures. As a result, there will be no fiscal impact to the Department of Environmental Quality.
