LB 154 would repeal sections of law containing references to various acts, boards, committee, task forces, advisory groups and funds that are obsolete. The fiscal impact of LB 154 is very minimal. The expenditure and revenue impact is based upon the following:

## Repeal of Commission on the Status of Women statutes and the transfer of unused funds to the General Fund:

Currently the Commission on the Status of Women has no active members and no staff. The Status of Women Cash Fund has a cash balance of \$898.22 as of December 31, 2008. This amount plus any additional interest earnings would be transferred to the State General Fund.

## Elimination of the Nebraska Veterans Cemetery Advisory Board:

A General File amendment to LB 154 incorporated provisions of LB 115, which eliminates the Nebraska Veterans Cemetery Advisory Board. The Nebraska Department of Veterans' Affair budget contains \$3,000 General Funds for expenses of the Board each year. Elimination of the Board would allow the Department's appropriation to be reduced by \$3,000 annually.
