LB 202 requires the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to implement an electronic lien system for certificates of title no later than January 1, 2011. Current fees for notations of liens are unchanged by the bill. Cancellations of liens are to be noted in the electronic lien system without charge.

DMV will have increased one-time cash fund expenditures for computer programming to develop a mainframe lien database, modify the AS/400 county computer system and establish an internet portal to allow entry into the system. The agency estimates about 1,845 hours of programming will be required for the project at an estimated cost of \$92,250 in 2009-10 and \$46,125 in 2010-11. Once the system is operational in 2010-11, annual expenditures will increase by an estimated \$67,700 to mail titles to motor vehicle owners after liens have been satisfied.
