This bill creates a new licensure category – special simulated pharmacy. It is a facility at an accredited pharmacy program located within or owned by a school or college of pharmacy. The fees would be those that apply under the Health Care Facility Licensure Act.

Because there are only two pharmacy programs in the state that meet the criteria for a special simulated pharmacy license, the additional workload can be handled by the existing pharmacy inspectors. The fees would be determined by the fee structure contained in the Health Care Facility Licensing Act -- a base amount plus additional costs that apply to the specific area of regulation. The total revenue is unknown but would not be significant since it is applicable to only to facilities.
