LB 390 provides that it is the intent of the Legislature to reimburse community-based providers of assisted developmental disability services on a daily rather than an hourly basis.

The bill does not change the total amount reimbursed to providers of assisted developmental disability services, so there will be no fiscal impact in terms of the total amount of funds reimbursed for services. However, the Department of Health and Human Services is unsure whether the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) will allow the department to reimburse providers on a daily rather than an hourly basis. If this is not allowed, then the department could be in jeopardy of losing about \$94 million of federal funds received annually from CMS.

It is assumed the bill will reduce the workload and possibly expenditures of community-based providers if claims for services can be submitted on a daily rather than hourly basis.
