This bill expands the scope of regulation of nail technology in two ways: 1) by broadening the definition of nail technology to include cutting, filing, buffing, shaping, trimming, polishing, coloring, tinting, cleansing, reshaping or other cosmetic acts not done in conjunction with application of artificial nails, and 2) by including treatment to arms and legs.

The number of additional persons covered by the regulations is unknown but likely to be small. There is no fiscal impact.
