LB 308 would allow fire protection districts to set their own property tax levy rates. Current authority to set fire district property tax rates resides with the county.

The bill would limit the fire districts to a maximum levy not to exceed ten and one-half cents per hundred dollars of taxable valuation of property subject to the levy.

There is no fiscal impact to the state associated with this bill.

No basis to confirm or dispute the general counties fiscal note.

IMPACT TO POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS:

The Nebraska Association of County Officials indicates that LB 308 does not appear to have a discernible fiscal impact on counties.
