This bill establishes the Stroke Registry Act. The Department of Health and Human Services is required to establish and maintain a stroke registry. Physicians and hospitals would be required to submit a report on every person who has a stroke with the specified information to the department.

The cost for the registry would be \$123,796 in FY 10 including start up costs of \$50,000 and costs for one full-time and two part-time staff and operating costs of \$73,796. In FY 11 the staff and operating costs would be \$69,068.

The University of Nebraska Medical Center indicates that a Health Professions Data Specialist would be needed to comply with the provisions of the bill. The cost would be \$84,000 in FY 10 and \$74,000 in FY 11.
