LB 279 would require city and county officials considering the adoption or amendment of a zoning ordinance or the approval of the platting or replatting of any development of real estate to notify any local military installation at least ten days prior to the meeting at which the proposal is to be considered. This requirement would only apply if a written request for such notification has been received from the military installation.

Any additional administrative workload should be able to be absorbed by the local planning staff. No fiscal impact.
