Current state law requires child care reimbursement rates to be adjusted to not less than the sixtieth percentile or more than the seventy-fifth percentile based on the biennial market rate survey. This bill lowers the minimum adjustment to the fiftieth percentile.

The increase needed to meet the sixtieth percentile based on the market rate survey is \$6,070,100 GF in FY 10 and FY 11. At the fiftieth percentile the increase needed is \$2,730,636 GF in FY 10 and FY 11.
