LB 378 requires that individual and group sickness and accident insurance policies issued or renewed in the state include coverage for routine patient care costs that a policyholder or his or her dependents receive during enrollment in a clinical trial. The Department of Administrative Services and the University of Nebraska are not able to project an actual fiscal impact of the bill for health insurance plans for state employees, but estimate any impact to be minimal. It is assumed that any fiscal impact for political subdivisions will also be minimal.
