This bill would adopt the Nebraska Claims for Wrongful Conviction and Imprisonment Act. All claims seeking recovery under this act from the state shall be filed as provided in the State Tort Claims Act.

This bill could increase state expenditures because it allows persons falling under the provisions of the act to recover up to \$500,000.

The amount of any expenditure increase is not known at this time. It would depend on the number of persons falling under the provisions of this act, and how much such persons are entitled to under the act.
