LB 595 would require drug testing of drivers and pedestrians (16 or older) who die within four hours after being involved in an accident. The drug tests are performed by the coroner and the results are provided to the Department of Roads. The department is responsible for reimbursing the county for the cost of such tests and has estimated that their costs will increase by \$16,000 (cash funds) annually. There is no basis to disagree with this estimate.
