LB 316 establishes a fifteen member Special Education Services Task Force. Members of the task force are to be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses. The task force is to examine the provision of special education in the state. Recommendations are to be made by December 31, 2007. The task force may hold public hearings to obtain input. Staff of designated state agencies are to provide research and administrative support. The task force terminates December 31, 2007.

It is assumed the task force will meet up to four times and may hold one or two public hearings in 2007-08. Based upon this assumption, the estimated one-time fiscal impact for administrative expenses and to reimburse members for expenses is \$10,000 of general funds. The funds will be appropriated to the Legislative Council.
