This bill would amend the Concealed Handgun Permit Act and state the power of cities and villages with respect to firearms.

The State Patrol estimates no fiscal impact.

IMPACT ON POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS: The bill states that cities and villages shall not have the power to regulate ownership, etc, of firearms except as expressly provided by state law, and any existing ordinances, permits, or regulations are void. This may have an impact on cities and villages that currently have such ordinances, permits, or regulations because they would have to change them in order to comply with the provisions of this bill. This impact is not known at this time but will probably be minimal.
