LB 575 changes provisions related to the initiative and referendum processes.

Under the bill's provisions, the Secretary of State, Attorney General and Department of Labor may share information pertinent to any employment relationship, compensation method and structure, and related information regarding any initiative or referendum petition circulator and any person employing or contracting with such circulators to ensure that compensation is in compliance with statute.

The State Patrol shall have exclusive jurisdiction to investigate potential violations.

If the Attorney General determines there is probable cause to prosecute violations the Secretary of State shall issue a cease and desist order suspending the circulation of the petition by the person alleged to have committed the violation. The Attorney General shall have exclusive prosecutorial power regarding violations.
