This bill would provide for data collection relating to persons released from incarceration. The bill has the emergency clause.

The bill states that the Legislature shall appropriate \$25,200 to the Community Corrections Council for the data collection required by this act. The Crime Commission shows the appropriation amount as General Funds, although the bill does not state the fund source of this appropriation.

The Department of Correctional Services (DCS) estimates no fiscal impact.

DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONAL SERVICES: Concur with agency analysis for DCS.

CRIME COMMISSION: Generally, concur with agency assumptions regarding the bill, however, Section 5 of LB 659 states: "The Legislature shall appropriate \$25,200 to the Community Corrections Council for the data collection required by Section 3 of this act."

This section does not specify a program, nor does it identify a fund type for the \$25,200 appropriation, nor does it specify a fiscal year timeframe for the appropriation, so placing the amount as a General Fund appropriation in FY 2010 may be inaccurate.
