This bill will provide penalties and change other provisions relating to sex offenders.

The Nebraska State Patrol (NSP) states that the provisions of this bill requiring notification to neighbors if a level 2 sex offender resides within 1/10 of a mile of them could be quite costly. The NSP notes that this provision would require major revisions in the current notification process. They note that it would be very time consuming, if not impossible, to use an automated process. Two other factors that will increase the workload of the notification process: (1) Notifying *new* neighbors, especially in apartment complexes where turnover is high, and (2) offenders who move frequently. The geographical notification provision in the bill would most likely require personal notification, and this could require a potentially high number of employee hours. The NSP estimates that this could translate into several full-time officers. The average cost per officer is \$81,120. The NSP also notes that there are neither specific notification time-frames, nor is the method of notification specified. These factors could have a significant impact on the number of officers required to meet the provisions of the bill.

The Department of Correctional Services (DCS) states that there will be no direct impact on them. Any impact to the DCS is assumed to be small, but indeterminate.

The Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) estimates no fiscal impact.
