LB 488 changes the eligibility for persons to gain admission to the Nebraska Veterans Homes. The bill removes the restriction providing that a person must have served during a period of war, thus allowing a person who served in "peace-time", and was honorably discharged, to be eligible for admission.

The bill does not change the total number of beds available in the veterans' homes in the state. It only allows different persons to be eligible for admittance to the homes. So, the bill should have no fiscal impact for HHS assuming no increase in the number of persons admitted for care.
