LB532 would authorize counties to enact ordinances relating to specific matters enumerated in the bill. Counties would be authorized to impose fines not exceeding \$500 in enforcement of related ordinances. Insofar provisions of the bill are permissive, any impact of LB532 is indeterminate. Impacts on counties as such may relate to development and codification of ordinances, enforcement of related provisions, and prosecution of offenses would depend on whether or not counties would elect to enact ordinances. In the event respective counties would elect to enact ordinances, related impacts would be dependent upon the nature and extent of ordinances that might be considered and enacted by such counties under authority granted by the bill.
