LB 566 creates the Public Recreational Liability Act. The Act, which applies to state agencies, including the University, as well as political subdivisions, limits liability when there is no charge for access upon the property. To the extent that the provisions of LB 566 protect the state and political subdivisions from future liability there may be a reduction in expenditures from its passage. Any savings is indeterminate due to the unpredictable nature of injuries and any resulting claims.
