This bill, as amended, would provide powers and duties and change membership of the Nebraska County Attorney Standards Advisory Council relating to death investigations.

This amended bill increases the membership on the Nebraska County Attorney Standards Advisory Council by four. Members of the council are entitled to be reimbursed for their actual expenses under state law, and the expenses are paid from the Crime Commission's budget.

The Crime Commission estimates travel expenses as follows: Assuming 3 of the 4 new members will reside outside Lincoln, and assuming the average round-trip mileage costs for those 3 members is \$.55 x 400 miles, then the added cost for one Council meeting will be \$660. This fiscal note assumes the Council will meet 5 times in 09-10 and 3 times in 10-11.

There will also be printing and postage costs associated with the uniform checklists and the standardized forms. The Crime Commission will absorb those costs.
