Sec 85-1502 currently provides that coordination of the community colleges by the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education is to be conducted through an association of community college area boards and further provides that all of the area boards are to be a part of and are to be represented by such an association. LB655 would provide that a community college area which has not met the association membership requirements of Sec. 85-1502 is not eligible to receive aid payments pursuant to the Community College Foundation and Equalization Act. The bill further provides that the Director of Administrative Services is to withhold aid payments from any community college area that has not met the membership requirements established by Sec. 85-1502 until such membership requirements are satisfied. Community college area aid payments are distributed by the Department of Administrative Services in ten as nearly as possible equal monthly payments in September through June of each fiscal year. Distribution of appropriated community college area aid for 2008-09 is as follows:
