This bill will change acting county attorney compensation and provide for county judge interchange. It also repeals the following sections:

Section 29-501 Examination; adjournment; period; prisoner; how sustained and kept;

Section 29-502 Examination; adjournment; recognizance; continuance; restrictions;

Section 29-503 Examination; forfeiture of recognizance; effect.

STATE IMPACT: It appears that this bill will not have a fiscal impact to the state. The Nebraska Supreme Court (NSC) estimates no fiscal impact.

IMPACT ON POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS: This bill may have an impact to counties. Currently, a court may appoint an acting county attorney and s/he is compensated under the provisions of Section 23-1204.01. It is unclear what impact, if any, this bill will have to county expenditures for acting county attorney compensation.
