LB 454 broadens the application of the homestead exemption to include those individuals who meet the Internal Revenue Service definition of blind. The bill is effective for applications filed in 2008.

It is estimated that LB 454 will increase the expenditures for the Homestead Exemption Program by \$895,000 in FY09 and \$940,000 in FY10.

Implementation costs for this bill are immaterial.

IMPACT ON POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS: This bill does not appear to have a material fiscal impact on political subdivisions.
