LB517 would authorize any two or more adjacent first class cities to (1) consolidate, (2) consolidate one or more elected or appointed city offices, or (3) provide for joint performance of any common function or service. While economies might be achieved through such authorized consolidation or joint performance of functions or services by the limited number of municipalities to which the provisions of the bill would apparently apply, provisions of the bill do not compel such consolidations or joint performance of functions or services. Any related impacts would apparently be dependent upon indeterminate future actions of affected municipalities under authority granted by the bill.
