LB 212 would give counties the authority to enact ordinances to address the control of dogs and cats, sidewalk obstructions, and towing. Counties are also given broad authority to impose fines and penalties. Since the enactment of ordinances and the imposition of fines and penalties are at the discretion of the county, the passage of LB 212 would have no immediate fiscal impact. Future impacts will be dependent on county action and cannot be estimated for that reason.
