LB 568 would extend the period of time that funding would be available for scrap tire projects. Current law provides that until June 30, 2007, grants up to \$1,000,000 annually shall be made available from the Waste Reduction and Recycling Incentive Fund in the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). LB 568 would require DEQ to make \$1,000,000 in funding for scrap tire projects until June 30, 2009. There only impact to the Waste Reduction and Recycling Incentive Fund would be the type of grants approved for funding, and total expenditures and revenues would not be affected.
