LB 425 would create the Nebraska Operational Assistance Act. The Department of Economic Development would be directed establish the program and select a single private, nonprofit organization to carry out the purposes of the act. Program purposes would include: assisting potential high-growth businesses in attracting private equity financing, encouraging the development of venture capital, identifying venture investment opportunities in the state, and serving as a clearinghouse for venture capital information and education. Based upon past levels of funding for similar venture capital programs, it is estimated that the program could be implemented with an annual appropriation of \$250,000 General Funds. All costs would be contractual in nature and additional agency staff would not be hired.
