This bill would change the jurisdictional amount of the Small Claims Court. The jurisdictional amount is increased to five thousand dollars from July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2015. Thereafter, the Supreme Court is to adjust the jurisdictional limit every fifth year as provided in current law. The bill has the emergency clause, and it becomes operative on July 1, 2010.

There does not appear to be a fiscal impact to the state or political subdivisions from the provisions of this bill.
