LB 161 would increase the maximum fee that could be charged by the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) to cover direct and indirect costs associated with processing applications for certification under the Wastewater Treatment Operator Certification Act. The current maximum fee is \$150 per application; LB 161 would amend the maximum fee to \$300 per application. The provisions of LB 161 would increase cash fund revenue to DEQ. The agency states that if LB 161 was enacted, it would raise fees from the current \$150 per application to \$160 per application. The increased fee would result in \$4,400 in additional annual revenue. Revenue would be deposited in and expended from the Wastewater Treatment Operator Certification Act Cash Fund.
