This bill authorizes a physician, physician assistant or advanced practice registered nurse who diagnoses a sexually transmitted disease to prescribe, dispense, furnish or otherwise provide prescription oral antibiotic drugs to the patient's sexual partner or partners. If the patient is unwilling or unable to deliver such drugs, the practitioner may provide the drugs to a public health official.

This would increase expenditures for the Department of Health and Human Services by \$1,700 each year for prescriptions for treating sexually transmitted diseases. Currently the department spends approximately \$7,400 a year.
