LB 1050 requires a second opinion regarding the cause or causes of death to be provided if the initial autopsy establishes that the death occurred under suspicious circumstances while the decedent was under the care of a child care provider. The second opinion shall be by a qualified coroner or coroner's physician from a different county. The cost of the second option shall be at the county's expense.

The provisions of LB 1050 will have some fiscal impact on counties. This will occur based on the number of suspicious deaths of persons while in the care of a child care provider.
