LB 781 amends section 18-2901 by striking certain language regarding the boundary requirements for urban growth districts.

The bill would strike the language requiring that an urban growth district be outside the municipality's corporate limits as they existed as of the date twenty years prior to the issuance of any urban growth bonds by the municipality. Absent this language the only specific boundary requirements for such a district would be that the district be within the municipality's corporate limits.

There is no fiscal impact to the state associated with LB 781.

IMPACT TO POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS:

With respect to political subdivisions, the bill does not cause any additional expenditures or revenues but could allow the earmarking of additional existing and/or future revenue.
