LB 906 amends the Nebraska Liquor Control Act, Nebraska Revised Statutes Section 53-177, to remove a distance limitation on the issuance of a license for the retail sale of alcoholic liquor.

Current statute states that no license shall be issued for a retail license for premises that are located within 150 feet of any church, school, hospital, or home for aged or indigent persons or for veterans, their wives or children.

LB 906 would change the language so that the 150 feet prohibition applies only to schools. Schools are defined by the bill as "a public, private, denominational, or parochial school approved or accredited pursuant to Chapter 79."

The Nebraska Liquor Control Commission estimates no fiscal impact to the State as a result of LB 906.

There is no basis to disagree with the Commission's estimate of fiscal impact.
