LB 713 requires the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) to prescribe a schedule for school districts to inspect children to ascertain if they are suffering from defective sight or hearing, dental defects or other conditions as determined by the department. HHS may also make available to schools methods for gathering, analyzing and sharing school health data.

It is assumed the responsibilities of the bill can be handled with existing staff and resources of the department, so the bill has no fiscal impact. It is also assumed the bill will have no fiscal impact for schools since current law requires the inspection of children for such defects or conditions.
