LB 692 amends Nebraska Revised Statutes Section 77-1311.03 to require that county assessors in counties with more than 100,000 inhabitants inspect and review all parcels of real property no less frequently than every three years. At this time this requirement would apply to Douglas, Lancaster, and Sarpy counties. All other counties would continue with the current statutory requirement of no less frequently than every six years.

LB 692 has no fiscal impact to State revenue or expenditures.

IMPACT TO POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS:

Lancaster County estimates that LB 692 would require the addition of nine employees and total expenditures for FY10-11 of \$632,010 and for FY11-12 of \$511,860.

Estimates from Douglas and Sarpy counties are unavailable but it is reasonable to assume an increase in expenditures for both counties in order to comply with the provisions of LB 692.
