LB 764 would allow natural resources districts (NRDs) located in a river basin that has not been designated as fully or overappropriated to develop an integrated management plan. It is estimated that there would be a minimal fiscal impact to the Department of Natural Resources. Any impact to NRDs would depend upon whether a voluntary integrated management plan was developed. If a plan was undertaken, there would be additional costs related to staff time and consulting expenses.
