LB 783 amends the Nebraska Liquor Control Act, Nebraska Revised Statutes Sections 53-103 and 53-177 to eliminate the distance restriction on the sale of alcoholic beverages near the main campus of the University of Nebraska – Lincoln.

The statute, as amended by LB 783, would then provide that, “no alcoholic liquor, other than beer, shall be sold for consumption on the premises of any college or university in the state.”

It appears that not only would this eliminate the distance restriction but appears to allow the sale of beer on the premises of a college or university.

The Nebraska Liquor Control Commission and the University of Nebraska both indicate that LB 783 has no fiscal impact to the State's General Fund.

There is no basis to disagree with the estimate of fiscal impact by the Commission or the University.
