LB 677 would extend a deadline under the Livestock Waste Management Act. Current law provides that individuals who are required to request an inspection under the act would be assessed a late fee if the inspection was requested after January 1, 2000. LB 677 would extend that deadline to January 1, 2008. There may be a cash fund revenue loss to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) due to the potential reduction in late fees. DEQ can not estimate the number of individuals who may request an inspection under the provisions of LB 677 and not be assessed a late fee. Any revenue reduction would occur in FY07-08.
