This bill as amended creates the Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Program. The bill provides for the Department of Economic Development to award a grant to a city of the metropolitan class in the amount of \$200,000, contingent upon formal notification by the Department of Housing and Urban Development that it intends to award a grant to remediate lead-based paint in homes. The bill states legislative intent to fund the one-time appropriation from funding lapsed from the Health Care Cash Fund in the Legislative Council budget.

Approximately \$185,000 from FY 09 carryover funding and \$15,000 from the FY 10 appropriation to the Legislative Council is used to fund this one-time appropriation.
