LB 686 increases transaction fees for recording property transactions. In most cases, the first page's recording fee is currently \$5 per page. LB 686 changes that to \$10 for the first page and \$6 for subsequent pages.

The Secretary of State estimates \$68,320 in annual revenue increase due to the bill's provisions. Since the bill carries an operative date of January 1, 2011, that annualized figure is reduced by 50% for fiscal year 2010-11 in the table above.

Counties will also receive increased revenue based on the increased fees. For example purposes, Sarpy county estimates increased annual revenue of \$330,000. Lancaster County estimates \$525,000 in increased revenue.
