This bill would change criminal law statutes to reflect Nebraska Supreme Court opinion State v. Conover, 270 Neb. 446; 703 N.W.2d 898 (2005).

This case stated that “the Legislature lacked constitutional authority to amend the language of the statutory penalty for a Class IA felony by inserting the phrase "without parole" after "life imprisonment" during the 2002 special session.” This was outside the call of the special session.

The Supreme Court and the Department of Correctional Services estimate no fiscal impact.
