The Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education administers the Nebraska Scholarship Program (NSP) under provisions of the Nebraska Scholarship Act. Pursuant to provisions of the act, scholarships are awarded to Nebraska residents who attend eligible Nebraska postsecondary institutions and who are eligible to receive a federal Pell Grant. LB745 amends the definition of "eligible postsecondary educational institution" for purposes of the act. Under current provisions of the act, eligible students attending for profit private institutions in Nebraska receive financial aid awards under NSP. The revised definition of "eligible postsecondary educational institution" would effectively preclude these students from receiving financial aid under the Nebraska Scholarship Program. The following table reflects a summary of the estimated impact of LB745 upon the distribution of Nebraska Scholarship Program financial aid to students attending institutions of the various sectors of Nebraska postsecondary education.
