LB 951 changes provisions related to voting.

Based on the bill's provisions, the Secretary of State reports that it would need development of the website to track early voting status of overseas voters. This requirement is found in section 4(7) of the bill.

The one-time programming costs are estimated to be \$80,000. There is no basis to disagree with this estimate.

As of February 23, the Secretary of State reports that the dollars it already has under the Help America Vote Act (HAVA) can be utilized to address this cost. These are Federal Funds that are appropriated from the Election Administration (cash) Fund. For this reason, the appropriation to address the bill's costs would be from a cash fund source.
